1. Venue

Directions from Durham Train Station: Lumley Castle is approx 15km from Durham train station, the most convenient way of travelling is by taxi, obtainable from the taxi rank just outside the platform.

Directions from Chester-le-Street Station: Lumley Castle is approx. 4 miles from Chester-le-Street Train station. It is then a short taxi ride to Lumley Castle.

Directions by car: A1(M) junction 63. Take the turn off for Chester-le-Street and follow signs for Riverside. You will then pick up signs for Lumley Castle. Free parking is available at Lumley Castle.

From London:

Direct trains run from King's Cross Station to Durham Station (approx. 3 hours).

From Newcastle Airport:

Newcastle Airport is situated approximately 8 miles north west of Newcastle City Centre. To get from Newcastle airport to Lumley Castle or Durham by public transport use the Metro which takes you to Newcastle Central Station for about 2.40 GBP (trains operate every 20 minutes) and then connect with the mainline train to Chester-le-Street or Durham. From there you take a taxi to Lumley Castle.

A taxi from Newcastle airport to Lumley costs about 40 GBP and to Durham about 45 GBP.

2. Arrival to Lumley Castle

If you are staying in Lumley Castle, please make your way to reception which is located in the main building of Lumley Castle to check-in.

Check-in from: 15:00

A room will be available for luggage.

Please see the attached information sheet (also available at check-in at Lumley Castle) for details of when breakfast is served and more information about the hotel and the services they offer.

On your day of departure, please ensure you vacate your room by 11:00am.

If you have an early departure and would request early breakfast if possible, please contact me or one of my colleagues at the registration desk well in advance before your departure day. We will try to arrange for an early breakfast pack to be available for you.

4. Transfer to Lumley Castle on Monday 15 July
