

 Research university (7,700 students, 18 departments, 530 academic staff)




- Landmark: Founder's Building (after: Chateau de Chambord)
- University of London: federation of 19 universities with 130,000 students also includes: King's College, London School of Economics, Queen Mary, University College London (but not Imperial College)
- Physics Department: 18 academic staff, 10 adv. fellows+emerit., 20 research positions, approx. 200 UG and 30 PG students Areas: low temperature physics, nanophysics/technology, neutron and X-ray scattering, condensed matter theory, CPP


